



Mr Bandicoot Mask Making Instructions!

WHAT YOU WILL NEED

PRINTER (To print out the template)

2 A4 SHEETS OF PAPER (To print the template on)

SCISSORS (To cut out mask)

STRING OR WOOL approx 60cm (to tie at ends of mask)

Once you've printed out the template get your scissors (an adult can help you do this if you're very little because scissor can be very sharp) and cut along the black line, don't forget to cut out the eye holes (so you can see) and the little triangles to thread the wool/string through. Once you've cut out part 1 and part 2 decorate them!

MASK DECORATION

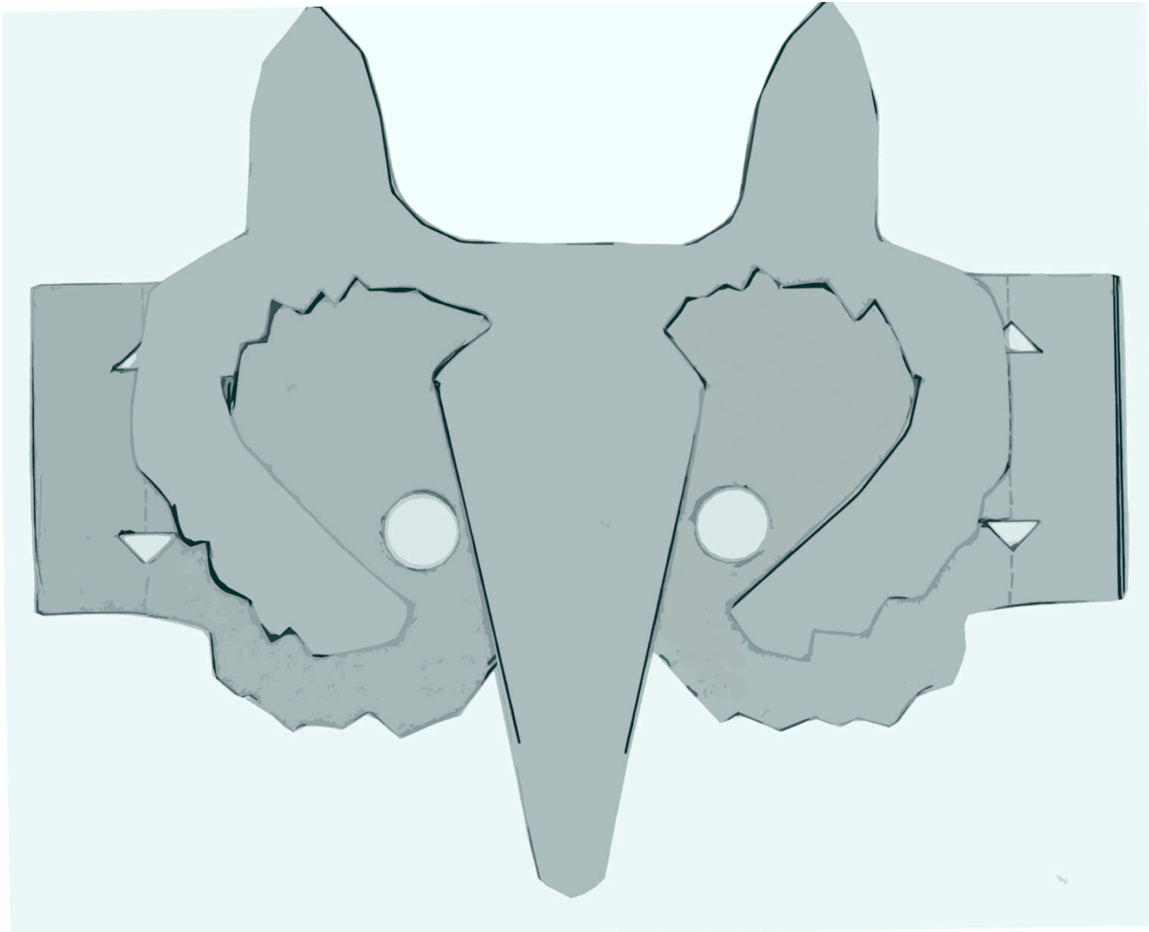
You could print the mask on grey paper (but it is not that easy to come by).

You could paint the mask grey once you've cut it out.

You could tear some grey tissue paper into little pieces and glue it on higgledy-piggledy so it looks like Mr Bandicoots fur.

After decorating, join the two pieces together as shown below. You don't need to glue them together they should sit tightly, but you can always add a dab of glue to make it more secure. Thread the wool/string through the little triangles at the ends of Mask part 1 and fold along the dotted line towards the back of the mask.

Your Mr bandicoot mask is now ready to go! So put on the mask, put Mr Bandicoot & Other Tales on the nearest stereo and dance your best Mr Bandicoot dance!
